Dear Ms. Free:

This is in reference to the complaint you filed with the Federal Election Commission on October 25, 2004, which you were informed was designated MUR 5584, concerning anonymous phone calls. Based on that complaint, on February 9, 2006, the Commission found that there was reason to believe Unknown Respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 441d, a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), merged MUR 5584 into MUR 5585 and instituted an investigation of this matter. However, after considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission determined to take no further action against Unknown Respondents, and closed the file in this matter on August 15, 2006.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). A copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.

The Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. *See* 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(8).
