On May 12, 2009, the Federal Election Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint dated October 10, 2008, but there was an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe that American Leadership Project violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 433, 434, 441a(f) and 441h(a). Accordingly, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to MUR 6094 will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
