The Federal Election Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint received on August 25, 2009. On March 18, 2010, based upon the information provided in the complaint, and information provided by the respondents, the Commission found no reason to believe that Tom White and Tom White for Congress and Thomas J. Monteith, in his official capacity as treasurer, violated the Federal Election Campaign Act 1971, as amended and close its file in this matter. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on March 18, 2010.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). A copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. *See* 2 U.S.C. § 437g (a)(8).
