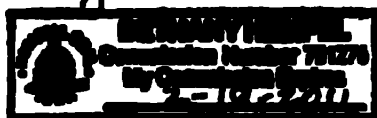

Those having studied closely each of these cards find it impossible to tell which of the oversized cards came from the 527 *Independent Voices, chaired by Red Brannan* and which cards came from the Boswell campaign office: *Campaign to re-elect Boswell*. All came from the same printing firm.

Under both federal and Iowa law, the Boswell campaign office was prohibited from coordinating campaign efforts with any 527 group also prohibited from communicating with those responsible in any 527 group. 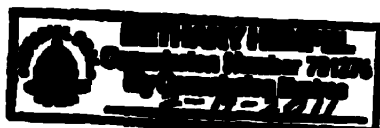

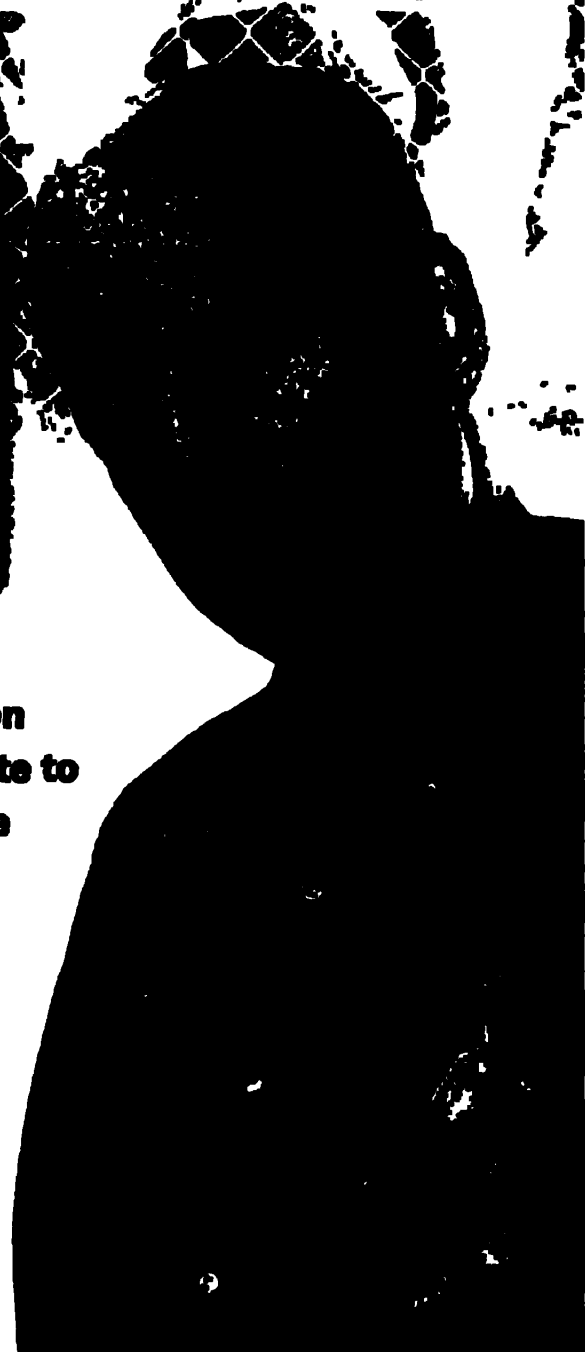
