By letter dated December 19, 2006, Jim Feldkamp for Congress and Patricia Siegmund, in her official capacity as treasurer ("the Committee"), were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that the Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(f), 441b(a) and 434(b), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. After the Commission considered the circumstances of the matter, on October 7, 2008, there were insufficient votes for making additional findings with respect to the Committee

Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the basis for the Commission's decision to close the file in this matter will follow.
